

What Not to Bring

Students must remove listed or other items identified as posing health or safety risks to the campus community when instructed by the Office of Housing and Residential Life and may be subject to disciplinary action for their reappearance.

The following items are prohibited in River Crossing Campus Apartments.

Air conditioning units

Barbeque grills

Candles, incense, and items that have an open flame

Carpeting is not allowed on walls or ceilings

Ceiling fans

Ceilings shall not be draped with fabric, netting, paper products or strings of lights

Electrical or kerosene space heaters

Flammables such as turpentine

Fireworks and other explosives

Fog machines

Halogen torchiere lamps

Lofts/loft kits

Open-element hot plates or appliances

Pets (exceptions: non-carnivorous fish and service animals)

Propane grills or liquid gas tanks

Satellite dishes and supporting hardware

Waterbeds

Weapons including, but not limited to, firearms, BB and paintball guns, knives and other weapons such as bows/arrows, blow guns and martial arts weapons

Wireless routers
